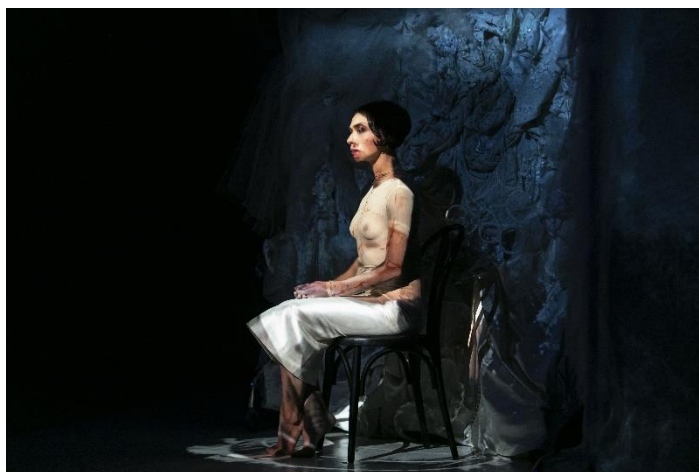

of an intangible world, at the same time though, so connected to the real one. In an attempt to trace the sensory, cultural and expressive matrices of an incorporated and sometimes alien femininity, image and word coincide, acting as visual expressions that shape and build emotional environments. The project is a journey within a house-body, in which different levels of language contribute to the building of a map that traces an experience of living. A long-term project, it has several ramifications and outcomes; 'Pelle delle immagini' (The Skin of Images) is the first movement. An emotive and hypertextual journey, spanning from David Lynch to Gaston Bachelard, from Balthus to Madeleine de Scudéry and Wim Wenders, exploring a web of connections across completely different styles.
