Thanks to a residency at Teatro San Materno, seven musicians from France explore the relationship between sound and space in both the inner and outer areas of Teatro San Materno. Their rhythm is also populated by the sound of silence.

All the musicians have graduated from the National High Conservatory Of Music And Dance Of Lyon (CNSMDL). Some are soloists in French national orchestras, some play in international orchestras, others are freelance musicians. "Octotrip" was born out of the need to combine the different influences and artistic experiences of the members within the collective with the aim of creating a unique repertoire.

Their music is notably inspired by composers Robinson Khoury (whose music is a combination of traditional jazz, world music and minimal music) and François Chapuis (whose compositions are inspired by modernism, early 20th century French music and serialism, twelve-tone serialism in particular).
